

HOW TO SCALE & PRINT A PATTERN



First, begin by measuring yourself and compare your measurements to the instructions in your download. If you are close to the measurements in which the patterns was designed at you can print without changing the scale. If you are larger, scale up to 105% if you are smaller, scale down to 95%. You may also scale in smaller increments if your measurements are closer.

To print, follow these steps:

1. Choose your **Printer**
2. To save ink, choose to **Print in Grayscale**
3. Choose to print Page 3 only (*pattern and assembly advice*)
4. Select **POSTER** from **Page Sizing & Handling**
5. Enter your appropriate **Tile Scale** (see above)
6. Choose an **Overlap** (*optional*)
7. Click **PRINT**

Note: An overlap will provide a visual guide for you to line up pages when taping them together. Also, the orientation of the paper does not matter in most cases, so you can choose whichever you prefer.
